## IELTS Writing Task 1 - Bar Chart Sample with Model Answer

The bar chart below shows the average number of hours spent per week on different activities by teenagers in the United Kingdom in 2000 and 2020. Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.

## Model Answer (Band 9):

The bar chart compares the amount of time British teenagers spent on five different activities per week in 2000 and 2020. Overall, watching TV and using the internet were the most time-consuming activities for teenagers, while outdoor sports saw a noticeable decline over the twenty-year period. The use of technology, especially internet usage, increased dramatically. In 2000, teenagers spent about 25 hours per week watching TV, the highest figure among all activities. By 2020, this number dropped to around 15 hours as internet usage rose significantly from just 10 hours to nearly 30 hours per week. Reading for pleasure also declined slightly from 8 hours to around 5 hours weekly. Meanwhile, outdoor sports experienced a major decrease, falling from roughly 12 hours in 2000 to just 6 hours in 2020. In contrast, time spent with friends remained relatively stable at about 10 hours per week across both years. In conclusion, teenagers in the UK have shifted their leisure activities from physical and traditional pastimes toward more screen-based entertainment, especially online activities, over the past two decades.
