Luc : What do you mean?

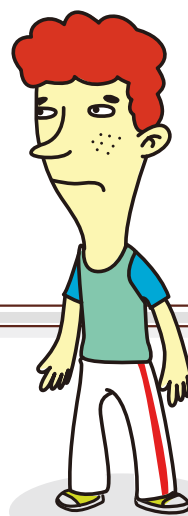
Flora : For example, San Francisco is a hilly city that still uses cable cars, but many other cities, like Tokyo, have elaborate subway systems.
